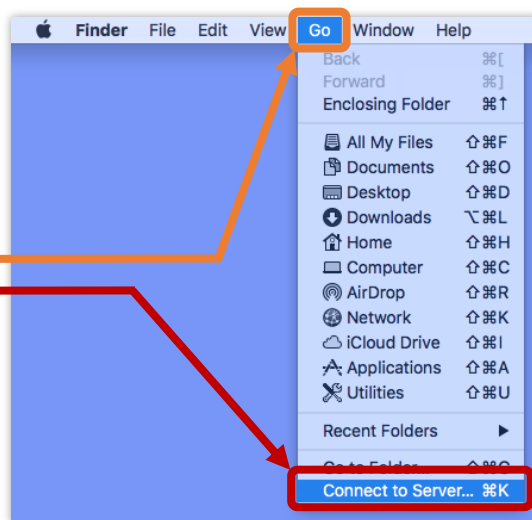




Connecting to College Shares on a Mac

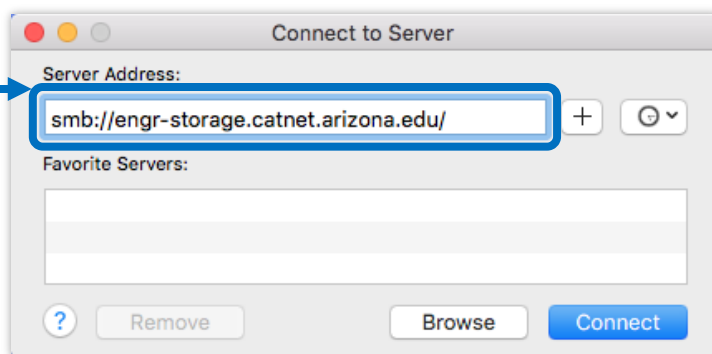
From your Mac desktop, you can either press Command+K, or in the menu bar, click **Go**, then **Connect to Server...**



You should then see a window that looks like this:

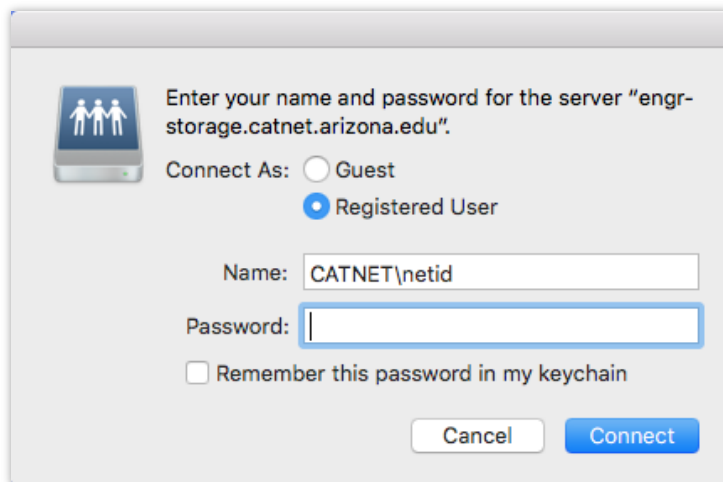
In the field for **Server Address**, enter **smb://engr-storage.catnet.arizona.edu/** and press Enter (or click Connect).

Note: make sure you are using forward slashes: / (as opposed to backslashes: \) In this particular usage, Mac uses forward slashes, whereas Windows generally uses backslashes.

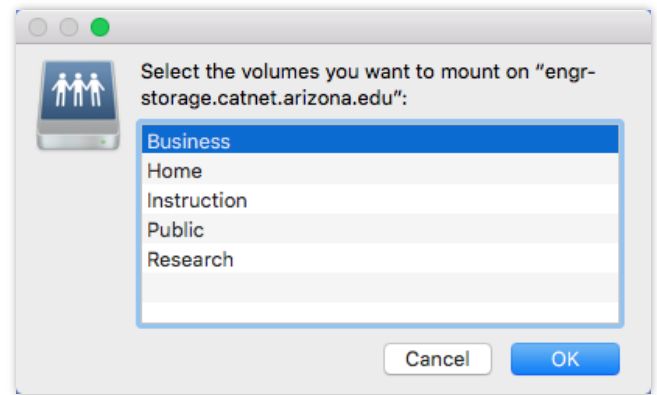


Next, it's asking for your NetID login- make sure to include CATNET\ before your NetID.

(In this spot, you will need to use a backslash, usually located just above the return key)



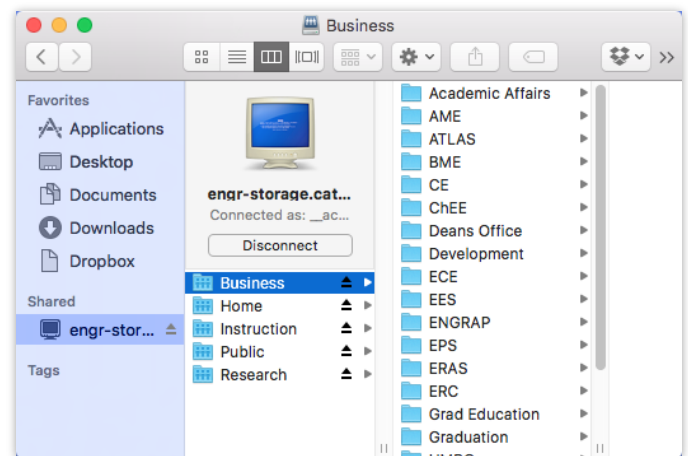
Here, select the desired shared drive, such as Business, or Research. Click OK.



Success!

You should now be able to see the drive you selected in the finder, and drill down through any folders (and any other drives) to which you have access.

You can also create aliases to the files you use the most by following the steps below!



To create an alias

Right-click on the folder for which you'd like an alias, and select **Make Alias**. An alias should appear right there, underneath the selected folder.

Now, you can either drag it to your desktop, or copy+paste it there. You can then, of course, rename it to whatever you like; back to 'BME,' etc.

Afterward, please make sure to delete the alias from the shared drive folder. Let's keep these shared spaces clean!
